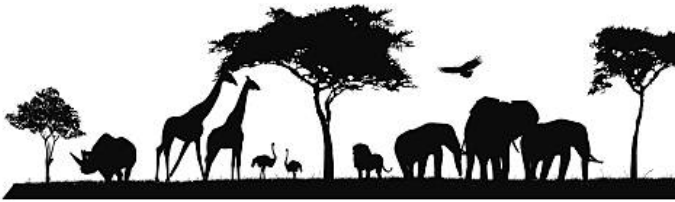
Going on SAFARI

COST: \$35 per person. Fee includes transportation to & from camp, snack, lunch & drinks, all study materials, craft supplies, life guard, T-shirt and liability insurance. The fee cannot be refunded if camper does not attend the entire week.

Additional fees for teen overnight camping apply. *See Overnight form.*

Financial assistance is available to those unable to pay.
